Ana Caban started her musical studies at age 10 and at age 12, she attended Escuela Libre de Música in Hato Rey Puerto Rico. During an orchestral instrument presentation concert, she became drawn to the profound sounds of the cello and decided that it would become her lifetime instrument.

After graduating in 1998 from Florida State University in Liberal Arts Music Performance, she traveled to Madrid, Spain where she continued her advanced studies with Maria de Macedo, who was an honorary assistant teacher to classical top recording artists like Janos Starker and Pierre Fournier. During her 8-year residency in Las Vegas, Nevada, Ana also organized chamber music for weddings and other events. In addition to her Bachelors in Music, Ana has earned a Master of Science in Entertainment Business and was awarded the Valedictorian award, graduating at the top of her class.

Ana has been trained in Classical, Jazz, Motown & Popular music through various opportunities including a Masterclass by Yo-Yo-Ma, who is known as one of the world's leading cellists. She has also worked under the direction of electric bass player, Jerry Brooking, who worked with Michael Jackson during his early years in Jackson 5.”

Through her vast experience, she teaches cello at all levels and teaches violin from beginner to intermediate levels. As part of her teaching curriculum, she has helped young cello students to develop and to appreciate the classical and pop performing arts.
